Coronary calcium scoring CT is a low radiation exposure procedure that many studies have validated as a useful test to identify coronary artery disease (CAD) and, in those with CAD, rate their risk of future coronary events. In those with known CAD, no clear benefit to further screening testing has been demonstrated.

The test does not replace clinical judgment and is best used in conjunction with ongoing care from your doctor. ***Most insurance plans do not provide for this procedure and therefore we expect payment at the time of service.*** If you are at risk for lung cancer because of smoking history or prior high dose radiation exposure, a lung cancer screening CT of the entire chest is available and could be performed at the same time at a discounted rate.
